	<i>I have the honour to request you Sir, to award the Degrees”.</i>
	The Chancellor then says:
	<i>“Let the candidates for the various degrees stand forward”.</i>
	(a) While all the candidates standing the Chancellor will put to them the following question:
	<i>“Do you sincerely promise and declare that, if admitted to the Degrees for which you are candidates, and for which you have been recommended, you will in your daily life and conversation conduct yourselves as worthy members of this University?”</i>
	(b) All the candidates will collectively answer: <i>“I do promise”.</i>
	After this, the candidates will resume their seats.

	Candidates taking the Degree of Master of Laws (LL.M.) “in person” will stand up, bow to the Chancellor and remain standing. When the candidates are so presented, the Chancellor says to the candidates:
	<i>“By virtue of the authority vested in me as the Chancellor of the National University of Study and Research in Law, Ranchi, I admit you as also</i>

	<i>the candidates 'in absentia' to the Degree of Masters of Laws (LL.M.) of this University".</i>
	The candidates receiving the degree "in person" will then proceed to the Chancellor one by one, as their names are called, bow to the Chancellor , receive the Degree, return to their seats.
	Thereafter, the names of candidates receiving their degree "in absentia" will be read out.
	BACHELOR OF ARTS AND LAWS [B.A.LL.B (Hons.)]
	The Assistant Registrar (I/c) will then present to the Chancellor the candidates taking the Degree of Bachelor of Arts and Laws [B.A.LL.B (Hons)] "in person" as well as "in absentia" in the following words:
	<i>"Sir, I have the honour to present to you the candidates for the Degree of Bachelor of Arts and Laws [B.A.LL.B (Hons)] whose names are set out in the list. They have been found qualified for the Degree of Bachelor of Arts and Laws (Honours) [B.A.LL.B (Hons)] to which I pray they may be admitted. Candidates taking the Degree of B.A.LL.B (Hons.) 'In person' will please stand forward'.</i>
	Candidates taking the Degree of B.A.LL.B (Hons.) "in person" will stand up, bow to the Chancellor and remain standing. When the candidates are so presented, the Chancellor says to the candidates:
	<i>"By virtue of the authority vested in me as the Chancellor of the National University of Study and Research in Law, Ranchi, I admit you as also the candidates 'in absentia' to the Degree of Bachelor of Arts and Laws (Honours) [B.A.LL.B (Hons.)] of this University".</i>
	The candidates receiving the degree "in person" will then proceed to the Chancellor by the right steps one by one, as their names are called, bow to the Chancellor , receive the Degree, return to their seats.
	Thereafter, the names of candidates receiving their degree "in absentia" will be read out.
	THE ASSISTANT REGISTRAR (I/C) WILL THEN PLACE THE RECORD OF THE DEGREES THAT HAVE BEEN AWARDED BEFORE THE CHANCELLOR, WHO SHALL SIGN THE SAME AND FORWARD TO THE RECTOR TO BE SIGNED BY HER AS WELL.
