Award of Gold Medals Regulation, 2015

1. (i) Gold medals shall be awarded on the basis of the criteria fixed for the said gold medal. For gold medals based on certain streams of study, they shall be awarded on the basis of the highest average of grades obtained in the courses of that stream.
- (ii) If two or more students have secured the same grade or grade average, then the marks secured by the students in the courses shall be taken into consideration in awarding the gold medals.
- (iii) If two or more students also secure the same marks, then the gold medal shall be awarded to the students who has higher grades overall. In case the two contenders have equal overall grades, then the grades in the compulsory courses and performance in co-curricular activities shall be taken into account.
- (iv) Along with the gold medals in the individual streams, the rank holders on the basis of CGPA shall be awarded the university gold medal for being first and second rank holders
- (v) The university shall also issue certificates indicating the name of the medal awarded to the students. The university may also consider issuing other certificates of merit or overall conduct at any convocation organized by the university
- (vi) A student who has been fined or has been expelled from the hostel /university for any act of indiscipline shall not be eligible for the gold medals. A student who has failed in any course and has cleared the course in a repeat examination shall not be eligible for award of gold medals.
- (vii) If a student has taken an improvement examination and if the grades of that particular course has a bearing on the relative standing of the student as against other contenders with regard to a gold medal, then he/she shall not be considered for the said gold medal.

2. The university awards the following gold medals to its B.A. LL.B (Honors):

(i) **University Gold Medal:** For first rank holder. University gold medal shall be awarded to the first rank holder student in B.A.LL.B (Honors) and LL.M on the basis of CGPA taking the program as whole. Provided that:

(a) The student must have completed all courses under the program in one chance i.e. without any repeat in any course and

(b) There is no proven charge of misconduct on the ground of violation of rules or breach of any disciplinary rules of the university

(ii) **Visitor's Gold Medal:** For overall best performance. Chancellors gold medal will be awarded to a student for overall best performance in B.A.LL.B. (Honors).

The Vice-Chancellor shall constitute a committee and the committee would decide the criteria for "overall best performance" for award of the medal.

3. Gold medal shall be awarded to deserving students at the convocation. The criteria shall include following-

(i) For gold medals based on CGPA, the CGPA at the end of 5th year calculated as per NUSRL Rules of Examination, 2010.

(ii) For gold medals based on specific subjects, the average marks secured in the compulsory courses and seminar courses (if any, have been offered) relating to the subject shall be used.

Provided, in order to be eligible for a gold medal in a subject, optional seminar course in that subject area (if offered) must be taken by the student.

For any other gold medals, faculty preference based on pre-determined criteria shall be used. (*The pre-determined criteria has been notified on the examination notice board*)

Explanation: In order to be eligible for a gold medal, a student shall not have written a repeat examination, unless it is a first attempt examination, in any compulsory course or seminar course.
